

In response to the request by the Mayor and Village Board the Waterfront Management Board advise the following changes to the Village Code.

Article III. Docks

Sec. 4-57.(d) Replace current (d) with; "Applications for berthing permits will be sent out before October 31st for the following season. Application must be made on the forms provided by the Village clerk and filed with the Village clerk accompanied by the required documentation and appropriate fee prior to January 31. Applications NOT returned by January 31st will forfeit the license agreement and slip. The Village clerk will assign the slip according to Sec. 4-57.(e)(1)"

Sec. 4-57(h)(1)b. Failure of the holder of the permit to use the slip.
Add, "On or about the 15th of each month from June thru October the dock master will record those slips not occupied. Any slip holder not using the slip without written permission from the Village clerk will be referred to the Waterfront Management Board for review, prior to being offered a berth next season."

Sec.4-57(m) Replace current (m) with; "The duty of properly docking a boat is at all times the sole responsibility of the tenant of the berth. At a minimum, each boat will be secured by six nylon lines of a least 3/8 inches diameter, or equivalent: two bow lines, two stern lines, and two spring lines."

The Village clerk will notify those individuals who did not occupy their assigned slip during the 2007 boating season for review by the Waterfront Management Board.
