Crafts of any kind are unacceptable (no duck decoys, painted furniture, jewelry, pottery, etc). Acceptance of any and all work is at the discretion of the Exhibition Committee.

 Fee: \$75 per 10'x10' tent or equivalent space; only \$55 for SBAA Members!
 Registration: 10:00AM–12:00NOON, at Bellport Community Center, 4 Bell Street; You MUST register before selling.
 Release Form: SBAA Release Form must be signed by each exhibitor at registration on July 4th. SBAA reserves the right to reject or remove any work deemed unacceptable.
 Displays: Artists will set-up and arrange their own displays along the sidewalks on Bellport Lane and are responsible for providing their own display materials and equipment. Displays must not block the passage of people. No part of the display is allowed on the street. Do NOT hang anything on fences.
